Black Diamonds is a pattern that was developed by Klaudeen Hansen of Sun Prairie, WI. Bill will describe step by step instructions to create the main quilt block including time saving tips. Feel you don't sew perfectly? That is "OK" because the pattern includes a fudge factor to achieve a perfectly pieced block. Once you learn to make this block, there are so many layout options, you'll want to make more.

Supply List:

Fabric requirements for approx. 60" x 78" quilt :

- 2 yds of assorted white on black prints, cut into 6" SQs. Collect multiple fat 8ths or fat quarters or trade with friends to achieve a wide variety. About 70 squares needed for 60 x 78 quilt

****Swapping some white on black fabric squares with your classmates is a great way to get a variety of fabric for this quilt.*

- 1 yd black (your choice) for outer border • 2-1/2 yd white fabric for background
- 2 yd or equivalent to make 140 colorful fabric squares (3") for the quilt blocks and additional 100 squares (3") for pieced border • 4 yd fabric for backing
- 3/4 yd binding • 70" x 90" batting
